The Heifer Project works in 25 countries and has for over 70 years. Their approach involves enhancing the capacity of vulnerable small-scale farmers, especially women, to secure their livelihoods.



Council Minutes

March 21, 2019 at 7:00 PM

Devotions: John

Meeting called to order at 7:05 by Moderator John Butterbrodt. Council members present: Bea, Dennis, Janie, John, Peggy, Sharon, Spencer, Steve, Sue.

- 1. Review, Modify and Approve the Agenda: Add 6D—Stained glass window, 7G—Highway Cleanup, 7H—Kitchen faucets. Approved as modified Peggy/Dennis/U
- 2. Minutes of February 13, 2018, meeting: 3C—correct spelling of DuWayne, 3E—add Konnie's last name, 7A—add "as choir director." Approved as amended: Steve/Bea/U
- 3. Committee Reports:

Christian Education: They have some concern on Sunday School attendance and are finding a cheaper, more leader-friendly option for new materials to use.

Worship, Sanctuary, and Membership: They talked about if they could do anything to help in finding a new pastor, but that is up to the council. Helen got the OGHS calendars and boxes. Peggy will help them prepare materials to be used on Maundy Thursday, like last year.

Building and Maintenance: The dishwasher held up through the meatball dinner.

Stewardship: March mission emphasis is OGHS.

Memorials & Bequests: They will meet in April. Sharon asked about what we have done with the Jeanette & Curt Olson Foundation proceeds and whether we should be donating some of that money. It could be used toward the stained glass window and new pastor expenses.

Pastor Parish Relations Committee: Not Currently Active

Wider Church Happenings: Pilgrim Point Camp is being sold. The proceeds will fund other programs. Some of the Fellowship money had been going to Pilgrim Point. It should be put on the agenda later in the year to discuss how to divide the Fellowship funds. Accept reports: Sharon/Peggy/U

- 4. Financial Report: We were short \$575.70 in February. The income from March is already better. Approve: Peggy/Dennis/
- 5. Moderator's Report:

It was good to see people coming to our church for the meatball dinner. John will keep soldiering on with Pulpit Supply.

6. Old Business: Janie is the bank's "control person" for our accounts. She still needs to sign the new form as a signatory on all of the Granite Falls Bank accounts. Janie will check with Tammy Anderson to see if the Christian Ed account is at Citizens Bank. John sent Jeff Iverson a thank you for his service as choir director.

Church bell: John has still received no response from Pyle to his email. Steve will take over on getting a mike wired to hear the bell better.

7. New Business:

- A. John will be attending the Conference Annual Meeting June 7 & 8 and invited anyone else interested to attend also.
- B. Chamber of Commerce: We will renew our membership, paid for by Memorials & Bequests.
- C. Becoming a Creation Justice Church: There is an environmental emphasis to this that fits with us. The Conference would like to see good participation. John will find out more at the Annual Meeting.
- D. Calling List: Changes were suggested to the list and Janie will send out a revised copy.
- E. Meatball Dinner Proceeds: Peggy acknowledged the Confirmation students who did the bulletin boards downstairs and in the conference room. There was \$2,577.21 in profit. It was decided to send a letter to the editor thanking everyone for their help in reaching this amount—Sue will write the letter. A motion was made to donate \$1,000 for Granite Falls Health's new van, \$500 for the Food Shelf, with the remainder going into the general fund for now. Peggy/ Spencer/U
- F. Pulpit Supply: March 31 and April 7 need filling yet, assuming Allen will still do April 14 and 28. Rosanna Walker will be asked if she is willing to do the Easter service. Larry Olson will be back May 1 and is willing to fill in again. John will check with Mort Myenburg about doing a service again. Bob Vedell could also be contacted again if needed. Felecia Faldet did not respond to any emails, so she will be dropped from consideration. Peggy asked about using Pastor-Parish committee to help with Pulpit Supply, but John is willing to continue this himself. Randy Moe has requested a meeting with Council members to find out about our openings. Those who are free will meet with him at 10 am on March 30th.
- G. Highway Cleanup: This is usually done around Earth Day, April 22nd. We will wait until next month to schedule a date.
- H. Kitchen Faucets: Dennis had Ims Plumbing look at the faucets—they've been repaired many times and need to be replaced. They gave an estimate of \$485 for 2 faucets and installation. Bisbee Plumbing estimated \$400. A motion was made to have Dennis contact Bisbee to install the faucets; Sharon/Spencer/U
