One Cup of Chicken FAT???

I was looking through some books at church and I found a GEM! A copy of a 1933 "Our Favorite Recipes." This was printed at the Granite Falls Tribune and distributed by The Congregational Ladies' Aid. I recognize many of the contributors from typing up the membership from the late 1880's. The next time anyone sees or talks with Pat Putnam, PLEASE ask her if she remembers this family recipe.

Prune Cake —Mrs. Josephine Putnam (Josephine was born on November 29, 1853 in Tioga County, New York. She died at the age of 81.)

- 1 cup of sugar
- 1 cup prunes
- 1 cup of butter or chicken fat
- ½ cup raisins
- 3 eggs less 1 white for frosting
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 cup sweet milk ½ teaspoon cloves
- 2 cups flour 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon soda in milk

Wash prunes and cut up fine. Flour them, also the raisins, and put in the cake the last thing and fold in.

Not sure how to frost, bake or at what temp, but I'm sure this will be interesting!

Devotions: John

Moderator John Butterbrodt called the meeting to order at 10:40. Members present: Bea, Dennis, John, Konnie, Peggy, Randy, Sharon, Spencer, Steve, Sue.

- **1. Review, Modify, and Approve the Agenda:** Add 7C—Meatball Dinner, 7D—Marco Contract. Change #9 to Steve and #10 to 10:45 am. Approved as modified: Spencer/Bea/U.
- 2. Minutes of November 17, 2021 Council Meeting: Change 3G from Sharon to Peggy. Approve as modified: Peggy/Konnie/U.

3. Committee Reports:

Christian Education: Circle of Stones winter time will start at 3:30 pm. Peggy is looking for new materials to use.

Worship, Sanctuary, and Membership: Christmas gift bags are being made up today. Anyone who wishes to help distribute them should let Sharon know.

Building and Maintenance: Steve reported that Stan got the snow removal done. Spencer has not yet talked to Greg Wilkening about the drain. West Central Sanitation will give us a 95-gallon recycling bin and collect every 2 weeks starting Jan. 7th. Dennis is still catching mice. Steve checked into locks for the doors with panic bars. Code doesn't allow deadbolts with panic bars. Steve will check with Wes Just for locks that combine key locks with panic bar action. Randy will also look into a remote operating system for the other and an intercom system.

Stewardship: December mission emphasis is the Christmas Fund and January will be Justice & Witness. The budget discussion was Dec. 5th and the amount for heat and association dues will need to be adjusted in January before the Annual Meeting.

Memorials and Bequests: No meeting

Pastor Parish Relations Committee: No meeting

Wider Church Happenings: John will contact Vickie Poier of Montevideo Congregational about the January pulpit supply date and explore the possibility of more cooperation.

Bremer bid for installation is \$850 plus cost of permit plus cost of metal casings. \$250 down payment is needed. Approve bid: Peggy/Sharon/U. Crimson has been selected for the color.

Clergy Care Grant--How will we use this grant: We need to include use on the application form. It was suggested that we get Randy a gas card to help defray costs of transportation. John will apply before the next council meeting.

7. New Business:
